CARPENTER FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP



Any youth meeting the following requirements may apply for the Henry County Saddle Club

Carpenter Foundation Scholarship:

- Parents must be a current member of the Henry County Saddle Club. Preference will be given to 4-H members.
- Must have a written recommendation from a community leader, teacher or minister as to character and personality.
- Must plan to enroll in an accredited institution for post high school training. Preference will be given to high school seniors.
- The Henry County Saddle Club Carpenter Foundation Scholarship will be awarded up to 4 youth in the amount of \$500 each.
- Henry County Saddle Club Foundation Scholarships are awarded to youth on the basis of 4-H youth involvement, involvement in horse related activities, financial need, community involvement, and scholastic ability. Scholarship recognition will be announced on <u>www.hcsaddleclub.com</u> website and mailed by post or email to members and notification will be sent to the Henry County Extension Office and Henry County Community Foundation.
- An interview of the candidates may be requested and the decision of the scholarship committee will be final.
- Receipt of the monies will occur by submitting your approved registration with the invoice to an accredited college or with paid book receipts. These can be mailed to the Henry Co Saddle Club at PO Box 5 New Castle, IN 47362.
- The Henry County Saddle Club Board shall comprise the selection committee for the Henry County Saddle Club Carpenter Foundation Scholarship
- Criteria for the scholarship are based upon the following:
 - \Rightarrow Essay 25% \Rightarrow High School Grades 10%
 - \Rightarrow 4-H Involvement 20% \Rightarrow Need 10%
 - \Rightarrow Horse Related Activities 20% \Rightarrow 4-H Involvement 20%
 - \Rightarrow Outside Involvement 10% \Rightarrow Recommendations 5%


